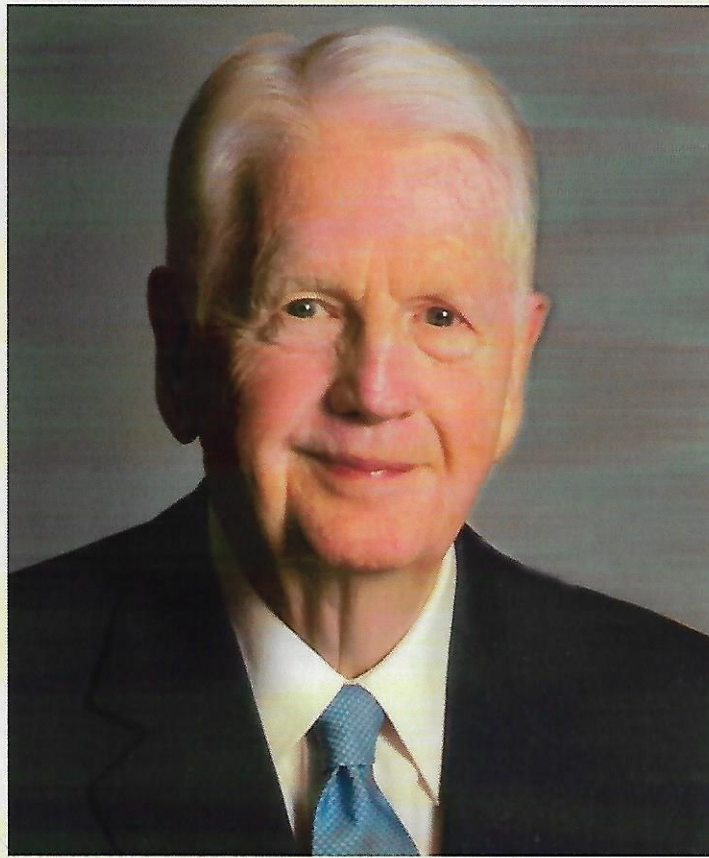

Sam B. Cook

This annual organ concert honors Sam B. Cook, a lifelong member of First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and a leading member of the Jefferson City community, who generously gifted the church with a new pipe organ in 2008 dedicated in loving memory of his mother, Gertrude Shuman Cook, and his grandmother, Olivia Hord Cook.

As a business leader and philanthropist, Mr. Cook was committed to making Jefferson City a place people loved to work, visit, and live. His civic pursuits were wide-ranging, including efforts to foster appreciation for the arts and increase the availability of affordable housing. He was a catalyst in the creation of the Jefferson City YMCA and the construction of the second bridge across the Missouri River. Believing in the power of education, he offered his service in statewide roles and on the boards of William Woods University, Washington University in St. Louis, and the University of Missouri. Mr. Cook helped fund the enhancement of health care locally as a major donor to the Sam B. Cook Healthplex at Capital Region Medical Center and the construction of the new SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital.

His various passions included architecture and music, so it is fitting that part of his legacy will be celebrated through this concert series that seeks to share the beauty of the organ and its sounds by bringing some of the world's finest organists to Jefferson City.

We are grateful to God for the life of Sam B. Cook, the tremendous gift of this instrument to First Christian Church, and the spirit of humility and generosity from which it was given.
