#### MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Memorandum of agreement entered into this 23th day of August, 1972, by and between Michael Quimby, d/b/a The Quimby Organ Service, Warrensburg, Missouri, party of the first part, and The First Christian Church of Warrensburg, Missouri, a corporation, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

- l. Party of the first part agrees to rebuild, in a good workmanlike manner, furnishing all parts therefor according to the attached specifications, and furnishing all labor, pipe organ presently existing in the sanctuary in second party's building located at Gay and Holden Streets in the City of Warrensburg, Missouri.
- 2. First party agrees to complete such rebuilding, and to have the said organ ready for use on or before September 1, 1973, subject, however, to delays from fire, water, strikes or causes not within the reasonable control of first party.
- 3. First party warrants that, upon completion of the rebuilding, said organ shall be of first quality, free from defects in material or workmanship, and warrants that he will rerepair or replace any defective part, or parts, at his own expense during a term of ten years after completion of the rebuilding, upon written notice advising him of the need thereof. This warranty does not include tuning, regulating or care of said instrument, nor does it include the console, which is guaranteed by its manufacturer for five years, nor does it include motors, generators, or rectifiers, which are guaranteed by their manufacturers for one year, nor does it include damage by water and other events which have no relation to operation. This warranty is conditioned upon the requirement that the organ must be tuned and checked twice a year.
- 4. Second party agrees to pay to first party therefor the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), as follows:
  - a. Eighty-five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) at the time of execution hereof.
  - b. Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) on December 15, 1972.
  - c. Twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) upon delivery of the organ console, or principal parts thereof, to the second party's building.
  - d. Twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) upon completion of the rebuilding of the organ and acceptance by second party.
  - 5. If, under the terms of any federal or state revenue

act now in force, or as may be enacted aubsequent to the date of this agreement, the sale of the items covered by this agreement, or the invoice or payments due thereof, are declared or determined to be taxable to first party as manufacturer or vendor, or if any sales or use tax shall be, or become, applicable, second party shall pay to first party an amount equal to, but not in excess of, such additional tax, or taxes, above any tax which has already been computed and included in the previously stated contract price.

- 6. Second party agrees to provide proper temporary storage space for the parts, such space to be in the room located to the North of present organ where present blower is located, except it is recognized that such room will not accommodate the console and other space will be provided for it. First party agrees to pay all freight and cartage in connection with this undertaking.
- 7. From and after the delivery of all items to the church premises, second party agrees to carry fire and extended coverage and vandalism insurance thereon, in an amount at least equal to the replacement cost thereof, for the benefit of both parties hereto as their interests may appear and be established.
- 8. To protect second party against first party's incapacity or untimely death, first party agrees to insure his life in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) and to carry disability insurance providing monthly compensation in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600.00), with all benefits under such insurance policies to be payable to second party. Any excess of benefits paid under either, or both, of said policies, not needed to complete performance of this agreement, shall be paid by second party to first party or to his parents (in the event of death of first party) in equal shares. The premium on the life insurance policy shall be paid by second party and the premium on the health and accident insurance policy shall be paid by first party.
- 9. First party agrees to carry proper insurance on his employees and to pay all employee taxes and insurance and agrees to hold second party harmless from any claims of first party's employees.
- 10. Upon completion of the rebuilding, representatives of second party will, in the presence of first party, examine said organ and if same has been rebuilt in accord with this agreement will then give acceptance of same.
- 11. It is agreed that there are no verbal or other agreements, or representations, except as herein contained, and any changes in this agreement must be in writing, executed by both parties hereto.
