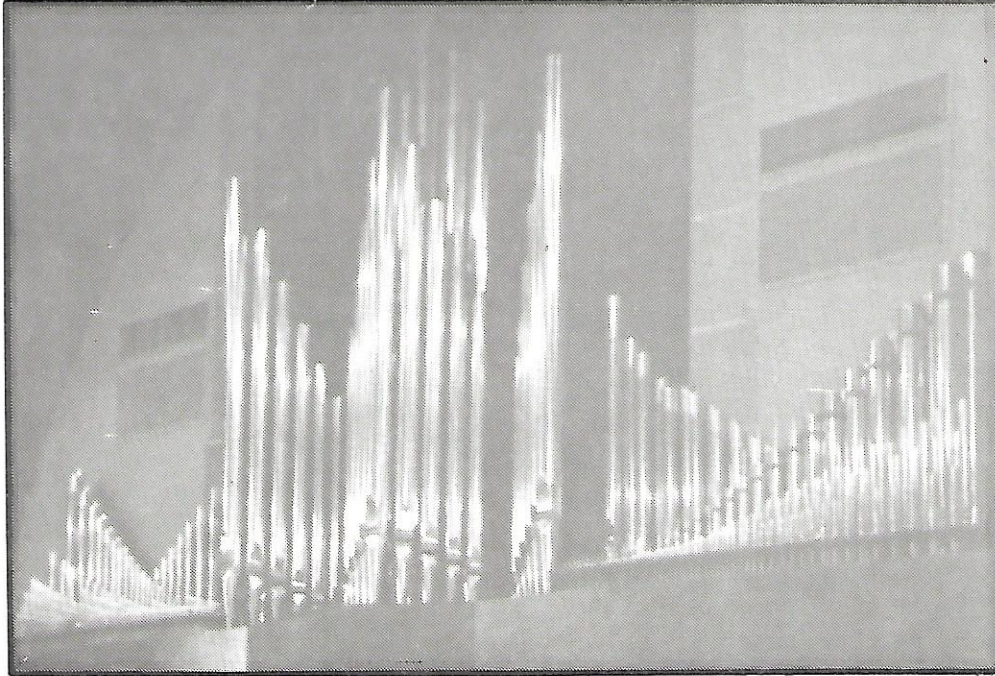


**MEMORIAL ORGAN

Julia Tatum Matthews, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James W. Tatum, resides in Columbia, Missouri with her husband, Steve, and daughter, Emily. Mrs. Matthews is organist at Community United Methodist Church in Columbia, instructor of music education at Central Methodist College in Fayette, and a graduate teaching assistant in music education at the University of Missouri-Columbia. She also teaches private piano and organ lessons.

A 1976 graduate of Poplar Bluff Senior High School, Mrs. Matthews received a Bachelor of Science degree in music education with an organ concentration from the University of Missouri-Columbia, and a Master of Music degree from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas. She is currently working toward completion of an Education Specialist degree in music education at the University of Missouri-Columbia.

Mrs. Matthews has served as organist at various churches in the past ten years. These churches have included First United Methodist Church in Poplar Bluff, First Christian Church in Poplar Bluff, and Park Cities Baptist Church in Dallas, TX. In addition, she was music instructor at Three Rivers Community College from 1980-84, and elementary music teacher in the Moberly Public Schools from 1985-87.
