Kevin G. Kissinger is a native of Kansas City. He attended St. Pius X High School prior to going to the Conservatory of Music of the University of Missouri. A student of Dr. James Evans, he won the Music Teachers National Association State Competition in 1979; subsequently, he won second place in the Regional Competition held in 1980.

From 1975 to April of this year, he was Organist Choirmaster of St. George's Episcopal Church in Kansas City, Missouri. Currently, he is Organist and High School Choir Director at Platte Woods United Methodist Church.

Having recently completed requirements for the Bachelor of Music degree in Organ Performance, Kevin Kissinger is also highly involved in Composition. He has written a number of choral and organ works and has a considerable working knowledge of the intricacies of synthesized sound.
