This is the celebration of the event of Martin Luther's nailing the 95 thesis to the door of the Castle Church, Wittenburg, Germany as the beginning of the reforming of the Church. With this event the doors were open to all people, to read and hear the Truth of God's Holy Word - the Bible. This event, and Luther the Reformer, stated clearly that we are all saved by GRACE ALONE, FAITH ALONE, WORD ALONE. WORDS OF WELCOME

RITE OF DEDICATION (spoken responsively):

- P: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. C: AMEN.
- P: Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands; Serve the Lord with gladness, come before His presence with singing.
- C: KNOW THAT THE LORD IS GOD: IT IS HE WHO HAS MADE US, AND NOT WE OURSELVES: WE ARE HIS PEOPLE AND THE SHEEP OF HIS PASTURE.
- P: Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and unto His courts with praise: Be thankful unto Him and bless His name.
- C: FOR THE LORD IS GOOD: HIS MERCY IS EVERLASTING: AND HIS TRUTH ENDURES TO ALL GENERATIONS.
- P: Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all the earth; Make a loud noise and rejoice and sing His praise.
- C: SING UNTO THE LORD WITH THE HARP: WITH THE HARP AND THE VOICE OF A PSALM. WITH TRUMPETS AND SOUND OF CORNET: MAKE A JOYFUL NOISE BEFORE THE LORD, THE KING. GLORY BE TO THE FATHER, AND TO THE SON AND TO THE HOLY SPIRIT. AS IT WAS IN THE BEGINNING, IS NOW AND EVER SHALL BE, WORLD WITHOUT END. AMEN.
- P: Beloved in the Lord; Our great and glorious God and the Father of us all in Jesus Christ, has made today a special day of rejoicing for us. Let us give God thanks as we dedicate this new pipe organ to His glory, and continual service on this festival of the Reformation.
- C: WE DEDICATE THIS ORGAN.
- P: To the glory of God who has redeemed us and made us His children through the death and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ, and through the power of His spirit, in the Word and Sacrament.

- C: WE DEDICATE THIS QRGAN.
- P: For the ministry of music to people; for the stimulation of sincere prayer and celebrative praise; for clear guidance of singlehearted worship of the Triune God in prayer and song.
- C: WE DEDICATE THIS ORGAN.
- P: To awaken the sincere spirit of devotion; to give cheer to the downcast and comfort to the sorrowing; to kindle courage for high and holy purpose and Christian living in those who hear it.
- C: WE DEDICATE THIS ORGAN.
- P: To humble the hearts of worshippers in awe before our great God and heavenly Father; to thrill the soul with the message of the harmonies of God's love; to stimulate the heart with the victory in Christ who has overcome the world and who promises triumph to His faithful followers.
- C: WE DEDICATE THIS ORGAN.
- P: And now this organ, set apart by the word of God and prayer, is henceforth dedicated to the worship of our Great God, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Let us now use this organ in leading us in singing praises to our great God. The opening hymn, "GOD OF GRACE AND GOD OF GLORY".
